Overall etiquette

- 1§ Student Union's overalls are used in national and regional student events. Overall is also used in Student Union Laureamko's events if the overall is not forbidden by the dress code.
- 2§ Overalls should not to be washed. Instead airing is recommended. It is possible to remove single stains if necessary.
 - 3§ Overall badges are attached by sewing. Use of glue is forbidden. It is recommended to reserve room for bigger badges or badge arrangements such as the RaflaRumba Appro badges.
 - 4§ It is good to have some badges that can be swapped with other students when going to national events. Suitable badges for swapping can be bought from Laureamko.
 - 5§ Do not cover any of the printed advertisements with badges.
 - 6§ Tutors sew their tutor badges on the left area of the thigh.
 - 7§ It is possible to swap a piece of the leg of the overalls with someone whom you've had an intimate relationship with like for instance your partner. Sleeves can be switched with a good friend.
- 8§ It is possible to modify and personalize your overalls by adding additional decorations such as bottle openers or key chains. Remember to purchase a belt for your overalls.
- 9§ Your overalls are officially "baptized" at the Overall Ritual event near May Day. Place the overall badge which is received after the official overall oath on the area of your right pocket.
- 10§ Always remember that when you are wearing your overalls you are also representing your school and your Student Union. For this reason, remember to behave properly and take others into account.
